

- APT role was implemented in most elementary schools.
- STAR program implemented in number of elementary schools.
- Enhanced ABA for Educators training made mandatory for all APTs and 69 out of 72 teachers completed the training.

- Star Program is made mandatory for all APTs and one CRT in the schools that do not have APT. There are 97 teachers trained.
- Special Education Consultants received STAR training in order to enable them to supporting teachers with the implementation.




